We have a dedicated and passionate team of teachers at the National Centre for Integrative Medicine (NCIM), who deliver both Basic and Advanced Homeopathy Training.

These courses are designed for Vets based in the UK and Europe who can come to regular teaching in Bristol and our on-line course is designed for those people around the world who wish to qualify in a Faculty Accredited Homeopathic Training Course.



COURSE DETAILS

Training is practice and case based with a focus on observation. These skills are used to gain a greater understanding of the complexity of disease, to learn how to match a homeopathic remedy to the pattern of symptoms and to increase choices when supporting animals with acute and chronic disease. We have a basic one year training to LFHom (Vet) and some may wish to continue for a further two years to qualify in the Membership of the Faculty of Homeopathy (VetMFHom).

The course is modular, with 9 teaching days per year, including clinical placement, to fit around a busy veterinary practice.

Assessment for the LFHom (Vet) is by an end of year exam and in subsequent years is by course-based assessment and a final VetMFHom exam.
