Blended Homeopathy Training for Veterinary Healthcare Professionals

Whether you are a veterinarian or a veterinary nurse, homeopathy can add value to the care that you offer.

Homeopathy training helps you to **widen the clinical options that you offer to your clients**, and can transform your relationship with other healthcare professions.

The National Centre for Integrative Medicine provides both **Foundation (LFHom) and Advanced (MFHom) training accredited by the Faculty of Homeopathy**. As the course is largely provided online, it can be completed remotely from anywhere in the world.

Course Details

Training is **both practice and case-based** with a focus on observation and holistic consulting skills.

These skills are used to gain a greater understanding of the complexity of disease, to learn to match homeopathic medicines to the pattern of symptoms, and to increase the therapeutic options for treating long-term conditions to support individual health and wellbeing.

The **Foundation course (LFHom(Vet) is one year**, and some may wish to continue for a further **two years** to qualify in the **Membership of the Faculty of Homeopathy VetMFHom**.
